The standing ends the weekend before entry. If there is a tie at 80th position, a draw will be made among the ties.

Rules: Riders must have participated in one of the barrel competitions listed in the competition locations section. On each weekend, riders can qualify for the right to enter St-Tite (depending on the results of the competitions). If a rider is already qualified in the first positions of the go, we take the following positions. The rider may present **only one horse in St-Tite**. When the rider is qualified, we go straight to the next position. When registering, **the rider can register with the horse his choice**. In the event of an injury to the rider, we move on to the next person who has entered, according to the place of competition.
